- If you are an individual (not family) currently staying in an emergency shelter or place not meant for human habitation (whether or not you have income), and want to be assessed for available housing resources:

  - **Please note:** *being assessed for housing does not guarantee housing, and it is possible you may not be eligible for any current housing openings. There is no fixed timeline for when an agency may contact you for housing after being assessed. This is not a housing waitlist.*
